Parents of high school students know that the SAT is probably the most important test their child will take in high school. In addition to your son's academic success at St. Joe's, his SAT scores will help determine which colleges accept him and the value of scholarships he may receive.

We are pleased to offer an extensive and proven SAT Prep program. **This program will run from 8:30am-2:30pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays from July 15-August 14 at St. Joe's.** It is open to current sophomores and juniors and will be run by Ms. Carrie Duggan and Ms. Kim Crotty who presented last summer's successful program. These ladies, both certified teachers at Northfield High School in Stowe, VT and Clarence High School respectively, developed and have taught very successful SAT programs in their respective schools.

The program is limited to the first fifty (50) applicants and will cost \$450 per student which will subsidize book fees and software costs (which includes year round access to College Board Testing Program). To enroll your son, please complete and return the following form with payment no later than Friday, May 23rd.

Highlights of the 2007 program conducted at St. Joe's:

- 28 students enrolled
- 90% of students increased scores in Writing, Critical Reading, or Math section from pre-test to post-test.
- 47% of students increased their scores by 150 or more points from pre-test to post-test
- 42% scored over 1800 (out of 2400) on post-test
- +124 average point gain of students from pre-test to post-test
